## Adventure Project: Quilt

For this project you will make quilt squares from paper, felt or other materials. Stitch or otherwise attach the squares together to form a quilt. There needs to be at least one square for the theme of your story and a five paragraph summary (can be split among several squares). AT LEAST four other squares should show characters, scenes, or symbols from the book.

| Quilt Construction | Quilt is not sturdy enough to be <br> folded and transported. It may look <br> like a poster rather than quilt. | Quilt is sturdy, can be folded and is <br> neat.
